IMPORTANT INFORMATION - before you begin installing

- The ExtendSim Academic Network License allows a specified number of simultaneous users to access the ExtendSim software in a network environment. It is meant to be installed in a computer lab where the computers are all on the same local area network.
- The Academic Network License is typically installed on individual computers that are networked together within one LAN. Or, atypically, it can be installed on one server that is on the same LAN as the computers that will access it.
- The course instructor is allowed to install and use one of the licenses on his/her computer, even when that computer is outside of the network.
- The Academic Network License is only to be used for instructional purposes or for research towards an advanced degree. It is not to be used for consulting or for any other private enterprise.
- Academic Network Licenses are subject to an annual Maintenance fee (ExtendSim Adopters must re-apply for Adopter status annually.)

REQUIREMENTS

-  Windows XP, Vista, 7, 2003 Server, or better.
-  OS X 10.4 + and a browser to view the Help
- 400 MB hard disk space and 512 MB RAM – 2 GB RAM recommended
- To run ExtendSim Suite, a 3D hardware accelerator card with 64+ MB RAM is required

COPY PROTECTION

- ExtendSim has built-in copy protection and can only be used with a valid site.tmp file. However, care should be taken to only install this license as authorized and to not distribute the site.tmp file to unauthorized users.
- If installed correctly, this network license allows a licensed number of users to access the program at one time. (The number of concurrent users licensed to your site is stated above.)

ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Network licenses are pre-registered to a License Administrator. Please contact Imagine That Inc. in the event of a change in the License Administrator.

INSTALLATION INFORMATION

It is recommended that you install ExtendSim on individual computers within a local area network (LAN). (You may instead install ExtendSim on one server, such that individual computers launch and use ExtendSim remotely over a local area network (LAN). However, installation on a server is NOT recommended since performance is considerably degraded when ExtendSim is launched remotely from a server.)

INSTALLATION

Follow these instructions whether you install ExtendSim on individual computers or on a single server.



Windows

Step 1: Install the ExtendSim "Network" CD

- 1 Do the installation on each individual computer (or, atypically, on a Server).
- 2 Click the "ExtendSim Install" button on the splash screen.
WARNING: DO NOT click the "Server Install" button. It will never be used for the Academic Network installation process.
- 3 Follow the Installer's directions. When asked to enter a name, enter any name you want; we suggest entering the name of the License Administrator. Your ExtendSim serial number and product code are found on page 1.
- 4 When finished installing, do not register the license (it is pre-registered). Instead click "Finish Later".

Step 2: Install the site.tmp file (*required to finalize installation of your Academic Network license*)

- 1 The site.tmp file was either emailed to you or is located on the ExtendSim "License Customization Files" CD.
- 2 Copy the "site.tmp" file from the License Customization Files CD (or the email you received) to the ExtendSim 8 folder (on Windows XP place in \My Documents\ExtendSim8 folder; Vista users place in \Documents\ExtendSim8).
- 3 Launch ExtendSim to complete the customization. The site.tmp file disappears after you launch ExtendSim.
- 4 If you are installing on individual computers (recommended), repeat this process on each computer.



Macintosh

Step 1: Install the ExtendSim "Network" CD

- 1 Double-click the "ExtendSim8 Installer" icon.
- 2 Follow the Installer's directions, entering the ExtendSim serial number and product code in the appropriate screens. Enter any name you want; we suggest entering the name of the License Administrator.

Step 2: Install the site.tmp file (*required to finalize installation of your network license*)

- 1 The site.tmp file was either emailed to you or is located on the ExtendSim "License Customization" CD.
- 2 Copy the site.tmp file into the ExtendSim8 folder on your hard drive.
- 3 Launch ExtendSim to complete the customization. The site.tmp file will disappear after you launch ExtendSim.
- 4 If you are installing on individual computers (recommended), repeat this process on each computer.

UPDATING, RENEWING, AND UPGRADING

Updating from 8.x to 8.x+

When new non-major releases of ExtendSim occur, all computers should be updated. To update ExtendSim, download the update file from the ExtendSim web site at http://www.extendstim.com/support_upgrades.html.

When you renew your annual Maintenance, you will receive the separate "Academic Network Renewal Instructions".
