IMPORTANT INFORMATION - before you begin

- It is recommended that you install ExtendSim on individual computers within a local area network (LAN). (You may instead install ExtendSim on a server, such that individual computers launch and use ExtendSim remotely over a local area network (LAN). However, installation on a server is NOT recommended since performance is considerably degraded when ExtendSim is launched remotely from a server.)
- The course instructor is allowed to install and use one of the licenses on his/her computer, even when that computer is outside of the lab network.
- The Academic Network License is only to be used for instructional purposes or for research towards an advanced degree. It is not to be used for consulting or for any other private enterprise.
- Academic Network Licenses are subject to an annual Maintenance fee (ExtendSim Adopters must re-apply annually.)
- Back up your ExtendSim files before you begin the installation.
- Once you have completed the ExtendSim Academic Network License renewal installation, move any custom files that you want to keep (your models, custom libraries, or extensions) from the older ExtendSim folder to the new ExtendSim8 folder. Then discard the older ExtendSim folder.
- Move any libraries you have built into the ExtendSim8/Libraries folder.

RENEWAL INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1 Renew the Lab License

- Typically this step must be done for each Client on the network. However, if you have a Server installation of the ExtendSim application and files, such that Client computers launch and use ExtendSim remotely over a network, follow these instructions only for the Server. (Note: installation on a Server is not typical.)
- The "site.tmp" file will remove the Maintenance Due message and update the Academic Network License with the new renewal date. This file may have been emailed to you, or it may be found on the License Customization CD.
- If ExtendSim is run directly on Client computers, copy the "site.tmp" file from the License Customization Files CD (or the email you received) to the ExtendSim 8 folder (\My Documents\ExtendSim8 folder on XP; Vista users copy to \Documents\ExtendSim8). If ExtendSim is instead used remotely over the network, copy the site.tmp file just to the ExtendSim8 folder on the Server. (In either case, do not copy the file into the Program Group window. You must copy the site.tmp file into the computer's ExtendSim8 folder.)

Step 2 Update ExtendSim

- Compare your ExtendSim release number to what is currently shipping. Your release number is located in the Help > About ExtendSim menu command. To determine what release number is currently shipping, go to www.extendstim.com. If there is a more current release than what is installed on your computers, do either of the following to obtain the newer files:
 - Download the update patch to each computer that has ExtendSim. To download the patch, either go to Help > Updates from within ExtendSim or go to www.extendstim.com/support_upgrades_ES8.html.
 - Or, if an ExtendSim Network CD was shipped to you with this renewal, insert the Network CD into each computer's hard drive and run the Installer.
- Whichever method you choose to obtain the most recent ExtendSim files, you need to install those files on the appropriate computers – either each Client computer or on the Server. During the installation process, you will also need to enter the serial number, product name, and product code.

Step 3 Launch ExtendSim

- When ExtendSim is launched, the site.tmp file disappears and Academic Network License information is updated.

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
